all that given, purchased or held in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

in the city of Greenville, being a part of lot No. 83 on plat of property of West End Land and Improvement Company. Said lot is described as follows:

Beginning at a stake on East side of Palmetto Street, said stake being 126.8 feet from intersection of Hayne and Palmetto Streets, and running thence in an easterly direction about 48 feet to a point on Chapin Street; thence along west side of Chapin Street 42 feet to a stake; thence in a westerly direction 60 feet to a stake on east side of Palmetto Street; thence in a northerly direction, along the east side of Palmetto Street, 42 feet to the beginning corner.
