## DEED TO REAL ESTATE

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That J. W. H. SuberIn the State aforesaid, ten dollars and love and affection for my son XX dollars.In consideration of the sum of ten dollars and love and affection for my sonOn 00 paid by John W. Suberin the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said John W. Suberall that place, ground or land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on south side of Piedmont and Northern Rail road and adjoining the right of way of said P. & N. Rail road and lands of W. H. Suber, fronting on Suber Road and having the following metes and bounds:-

Beginning on iron pin on right of way of Piedmont and Northern Rail road, thence N.  $82\frac{1}{2}$  E. 2.50 chains to iron pin in Suber Road, thence with Suber Road S.  $62\frac{1}{2}$  E. 3.16 chains to iron pin in Suber Road thence S.  $84\frac{1}{2}$  W. 2.50 chains to iron pin, thence N.  $82\frac{1}{2}$  W. 3.16 chains to beginning corner, and containing .79 of an acre more or less according to survey made by J. Earle Freeman March 20, 1927.
