for the following use, viz: Mercantile purposes

for the term of two years from Dec. 1st, 1937 with the privilege of 2 years additional at \$5.00 per month

and the said lessee in consideration of the use of said premises for the said term, promises to pay the said lessor the sum of Six Hundred and

22/100 Dollars

per month payable in advance, monthly

The lessee hereby agrees to take the building just as it stands unless otherwise agreed upon in writing, and the lessor only requires of the lessor the use of the premises for the business mentioned but no other. The lessor to repair the roof should it leak, it is also fully agreed that the roof is considered sound and the lessor not to pay any damages from leaks should any occur. Use of the premises for any business other than herein called for shall cancel this lease if the lessor so desires and give notice of same in writing.

If the business be discontinued on the premises wanted before the expiration of the lease even the whole of the unexpired time becomes immediately due and payable.

Outside signs to be erected that may connect with the gutter or any other outside part of the building must be consented to by the lessor before being erected.
