KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, THAT I, Sarah Calhoun, of the county of Greenville

in the State aforesaid,

in consideration of support and maintenance to be furnished me and my husband ~~XXXXXX~~ by the grantee herein during our natural lives and in further consideration of the sum of twenty-five hundred--Dollars,

to ~~me~~ Alfazata Calhoun, in hand paid as and before the writing of these presents by

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Alfazata Calhoun,

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the county and state aforesaid, in the city of Greenville (described in deed of John C. Bailey, Judge of the Court Probate to Sarah Burns, now Sarah Burns Calhoun, as those certain lots of land) adjoining lands of Mrs. A. C. Davis, Alexander Singleton and others, containing one and three-fourths acres, more or less, being the premises whereon Sanders Burns, deceased, lived at the time of his death, and being the same lot of land conveyed to Sarah Burns Calhoun by deed dated 1st, day of March, 1897, and said deed being recorded in the R. M. C. Office for said county, in deed book DDD, at page 46.

Also all that other piece, parcel or lot of land lying in Greenville county, located on the Augusta Road, about one and a half miles from the Court House, containing four and six-tenths acres, more or less, being the home place of Judy Nesbitt, said place having been conveyed to her by Albert Nesbitt, her husband, on Oct. 14th, 1890, said deed being recorded in R. M. C. office for Greenville County, in deed book BBB, at page 577, the said Albert Nesbitt having obtained said land from R. H. Earle, in December 1880, the deed thereto being duly on record in R. M. C. Office, said county and state, in book LL, at page 573, and being the same lot of land conveyed to Sarah Burns Calhoun, by T. K. Earle, administrator, see R. M. C. Deed Book ZZZ, at page 319.

Also all that other certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the county and state aforesaid, within the corporate limits of the city of Greenville, containing one-fourth of an acre, more or less, and bounded by lands of Ed. Kirby, W. H. Irvine and Dan Arnold, on Sullivan Street, being the same lot conveyed by Margaret Harrison to Thomas G. Davis and W. P. Conyers, said deed being recorded in R. M. C. office for said county and state, in book PFP, at page 184, and latter conveyed to Margaret Harrison by said Davis and Conyers, and later Margaret Harrison conveyed one-half interest in and to the above described premises to Peter Calhoun; and being the same lot of land conveyed by Margaret Harrison and Peter Calhoun, ^{to Sarah Calhoun} see deed book JJJ, at page 516.
