(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Conveyed, Bargained, Sold and Delivered, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

I. J. Southerlin, his heirs and assigns forever, the following described land:

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land, situate, lying and being in Greenville Township, County and State aforesaid containing Twenty-eight and 35/100 (28.35) acres, more or less and being a portion of the lands conveyed to J. G. Huff, R. W. Goldsmith, and A. G. Garrison, and conveyed to I. J. K. Phillips by J. G. Huff, and Henry Brown as a part of the Elliston Tract, containing the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at a point on Settlement Road, at corner of tract No. 3, and running thence S. 30° 15' E. 575 feet, thence S. 42° 30' E. 116.3 feet; thence N. 7° 15' E. 110 feet, thence N. 30° 15' E. (35 1/2) 516 feet, thence N. 45° 05' E. 347 feet, thence N. 56. 45 W. 10 feet, thence N. 45° 35' E. 316 feet, thence N. 30° 21' 48 feet to an iron pier in road; thence S. 56. 30 E. 835 feet, thence N. 81. 50 E. 726 feet to the beginning corner.

The above described land being a portion of the old Goldsmith and Agnew farm, and represented upon a Plat record'd in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, in Plat Book A, page 554 and being a portion of lots Nos. 3, 2, 2, and 25 and all of lot No. 1, 24 and 25, as set forth upon said plat.

This being the same tract of land conveyed to me by J. G. Huff by deed dated January 11, 1921, and record'd in the R. M. C. Office for said County and State in Vol. 69 at Page 156.

Less however twelve (12) acres more or less out of the above tract conveyed by me, I. J. K. Phillips, to Bishop Bishop by deed dated 1926, and record'd in the R. M. C. Office of said County and State in Deed Book 109 at Page 34. Reference to said deed is hereby made. This leaving thirteen and 35/100 acres, more or less in the original tract which is being conveyed by this deed.
