Crowell Pitman: All that certain piece or parcel of land lying & situate in Glassy Mt. Township, State and State aforesaid, on Jamison Mill Creek, containing 54.50 acres, more or less, and having the following metes & bounds: Beginning at a stake on Mill Creek and running N. 80.25° E. 5.50 ch. to a stake; thence S. 6.36° E. 3.12 ch. to a stone; thence S. 40.45° E. 13.30 ch. to a stone; thence S. 40.20° E. 16.05 ch. to a stake; thence N. 68.10° E. 4.55 ch. to a large P.O. box; thence N. 7.20° N. 28.16 ch. to a stake; thence N. 10.20° N. 8.67 ch. to a stake; thence S. 79.45° N. 15.26 ch. to a stake; thence N. 6.36° N. 7.57 ch. to a stake; thence S. 63.32° N. 5.70 ch. to a stake on Mill Creek; thence with Mill Creek 13.00 ch. to the beginning. Bounded by lands of B. F. Campbell, B. F. A. Prewitt, & estate, Mill Creek, Harriet Stewart, J. O. Barnett, B. S. Tallant and the O'Shields land, and being the same land owned by Margaret A. Township, County & State aforesaid, Beginning on a stone and running N. 42° W. 13.00 ch. to a stone; thence N. 75° W. 3.05 ch. to an iron pin; thence S. 80° W. 1.50 ch. to an iron pin; thence S. 8 1/2° E. 13.89 ch. to a point in ditch; S. 25° E. 58 links to an iron pin on the line; thence N. 69° E. 9.45 ch. to stone, beginning corner, containing 6.87 acres, bounded by lands of W. G. Lindsay & others, the same conveyed to Crowell Pitman by Pearl Lindsay Stewart 22 Nov. 1929, recorded 20 Dec. 1929 in Vol. 152 Page 104.
