Meace, All our right, title and interest in and to, that certain piece, parcel or tract of land, lying in Oneal Township, Greenville County, on the head-waters of Enoree River, containing eleven (11.00) acres, more or less, and having the following courses and distances and bounds to wit: Beginning at an iron stake on North side of County Highway at line of Ernest Sammons, as is shown on plat hereinafter referred to, thence N. 87 W. 14.00 chs., to stake on bank of Enoree River, thence with the east bank of the said river to an iron stake at corner of Tate land thence N. 32 E. 4.08 chs. to iron pin, thence S. 73 E. 22.00 to iron pin on north side County highway, thence S. 32 W. with edge of road 5.00 chs. to beginning corner, being a part of estate lands of Geo.
