Baker will irrevocably will to Ethel Bayne, Ruby Bayne, Almas Bayne, Hazel Bayne, Willie Bayne and Bobby Bayne, grand children of said G. E. Baker, the part of the estate, personal and real property of said G. E. Baker which said children should inherit as distributees.

The said J. M. Bayne hereby covenants and agrees to release, relinquish and forever discharge said G. E. Baker from any and all liabilities by virtue of a certain counterclaim in the afore mentioned suit pending in the County Court, in and for Greenville County, and hereby withdraws same and further authorizes said G. E. Baker to have same marked ended.

The said J. M. Bayne further covenants and agrees to release, relinquish and forever discharge said G. E. Baker and B. S. Baker from any and all liabilities to said J. M. Bayne arising from a physical combat between said parties on the 29th day of November, 1932, at Fort Shoals, South Carolina.

The said J. M. Bayne further covenants and agrees to release, relinquish and forever discharge said B. S. Baker from all liabilities arising in connection with a certain pistol owned by said John R. Gaynor.

The parties hereto further covenant and agree with each other that they will hereafter be, and remain, friends and business, with no hard feelings or ill will, either man toward the other.
