She said E. C. Baker hereby, for himself, and for his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, does hereby covenant and agree to and with said J. M. Bayne, his heirs and assigns, that said E. C. Baker will irrevocably will to Ethel Bayne, Ruby Bayne, Alma Bayne, Hazel Bayne, Willie Bayne and Bobby Bayne, grand children of said E. C. Baker, the part of the estate, personal and real property of said E. C. Baker which said children shall inherit as distributees.

She said J. M. Bayne hereby covenants and agrees to release, relinquish and forever discharge said E. C. Baker from any and all liabilities by virtue of a certain counterclaim in the afore mentioned suit pending in the County Court, in and for Greenville County, and hereby withdraws same and further authorizes said E. C. Baker to have same marked ended.

She said J. M. Bayne further covenants and agrees to release, relinquish and forever discharge said E. C. Baker and B. L. Baker from any and all liabilities to said J. M. Bayne arising from a physical combat between said parties on the 24th Day of November, 1922, at Fork Shoals, South Carolina.

She said J. M. Bayne further covenants and agrees to release, relinquish and forever discharge, and does hereby, release, relinquish and forever discharge said B. L. Baker from all liabilities arising in connection with a certain pistol owned by said John B. Bayne.

She parties hereto further covenant and agree with each other that they will hereafter be, and remain, friends and neighbors, with no hard feelings or ill will, or ill will toward the other.
