Know all men by these presents, that we, J. R. Wilkinson, Sr., M. D., and Annie Barr Wilkinson, being the owners of certain personal property, which includes stocks, bonds, notes, mortgages or any other personal property, and any real property which we now have or may acquire in the State of South Carolina, do hereby make, constitute, and appoint our son George R. Wilkinson, of Greenville, South Carolina, our true and lawful attorney for us and in our name, place and stead, to receive and collect any and all money or monies now due or to become due us from any and every source, within said State, and to issue the proper receipt for the same, and in our name and stead to buy or sell any and all of said property, and for any property sold to convey a fee simple title to the same and for any real estate to give a general warranty deed; to execute any papers or bring any suit or suits necessary in connection with the above powers.

Any and all monies collected as above set forth, by the said George R. Wilkinson, are to be divided in half, one half of said amount to be deposited in a bank designated by us in the joint names of the said George R. Wilkinson and J. R. Wilkinson, Sr., M. D., the other half of said monies to be deposited in a bank designated by us in the joint names of the said George R. Wilkinson and Annie Barr Wilkinson.

For the purposes herein stated we do give to our said attorney all the powers which we have or might have with reference to any and all of the property aforesaid.
