

Lease.

S. L. Stps #116

State of South Carolina
County of Greenville

These articles of agreement made
and entered into at Greenville, S. C. this 28th day
of February 1935 by and between Anna Gassett
lessor after known as lessor, and S. M. Boynton
hereinafter known as lessee, witness:

That at the expiration of the lease
held by the lessor, which expiration is July 31, 1935
the lessor makes this lease beginning August
1, 1935, to the lessee, to wit:

That the lessor leases unto the lessee
the store room located on the corner of Pendleton
and Willis Streets now occupied by the lessor,
S. M. Boynton, and in the City of Greenville,
said County and State, the rent beginning
August 1, 1935 and continuing through July 31, 1935
is fixed at forty-five Dollars (\$45.00) a month
payable at the end of each month, to be paid
by the lessor and said store room, where called
for. Thereafter, for the next three years running
from August 1, 1935 through July 31, 1940, the lessor
shall pay the like sum of Fifty Dollars a month.
This lessor shall therefore ren for a period of
five years from August 1, 1935 through July 31, 1940.
The lessor is to take good care of the
building, but is not to be responsible except
in case of negligence on his part. If there is
any accidental breakage of glass not due to
the lessor's fault, the lessor will repair the same
if a fee occurs, the lessor will repair the
building. But practically complete destruction
by fire will void the lease. In the event the
building is repaired where a fire occurs, the
rent is not to be charged for the period during
which the store is repaired.

It is further agreed between the
lessor and lessee that at the end of this
lease, the lessor shall continue to retain the
store room at the option upon the same
terms to wait Sept. (50.00) Dollars and five
unless and until the lessor shall give
twelve months notice to vacate. He will
have twelve months from the time he has given
to which to move out and vacate said store.
This lease is made for the benefit of the lessor
and lessee, their respective executors, administrators
heirs and assigns.
