the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged have Granted, Bargain, Sold and Released unto the said  
Mary M. Balhoun, her heirs and assigns;

All that piece parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, in the State and  
County aforesaid, in the City of Greenville, and on the East side of South Calhoun Street  
having the following metes and bounds:  
Beginning 100 feet South from Dunbar Street on the East side of South Calhoun  
Street at Howard's corner; thence with Howard, S. L. Balhoun, and Dan Richardson  
line easterly about 191 feet to Tribble Alley; thence along Tribble Alley southerly  
42 feet to a pin; thence parallel with Dunbar Street westerly, (this line  
dividing the cut building containing waterworks, plumbing and  
electrics) about 97 feet; thence running parallel with South Calhoun  
Street southerly 16 feet; thence westerly parallel with Dunbar Street  
about 106 feet to South Calhoun Street; thence with South Calhoun Street  
northerly 56 feet to the beginning corner.
