General Permit

Received of the State of South Carolina through the South Carolina State Forestry Commission, One and no/100 (\$1.00) Dollars in consideration of which I hereby grant unto said Commission, its successors and mesigns, the right, privilege and authority to construct, operate and maintain its lines of telephone, including the ssary poles, wires, and fixtures upon, over and across the property which I own or in which I have an interest, in the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina, and upon and along the roads or highways adjoining said property; said sum is received in full payment for said right, and also for the right to permit the attachment of the wires of any other company, or person to said poles and fixtures, and the right to trim and cut trees along said lines so as to clear and keep the wires cleared at least 20 feet, and the right to cut all dead or dying trees that in falling would reach the wire, and the further right to erect and set the necessary guy and brace poles and anohors, and to attach thereto and to trees the necessary guy wires; said sum being received in full payment therefor. Said right-of-way is described as follows: Across land of H. M. Cantrell about 100 feet South of his home and beginning on the East at property of the Saluda Land and Lumber Co. and running in a westerly direction to land of M. C. Faysus a distance of approximately three-fourths mile.
