LEASE

MEMORANDUM OF ACRESMENT made at Greenville, S. C., this the 25th day of July, 1933, by and between D. M. Payne, party of the first part, hereinafter called the Lesson, end Dixie Stores, Inc., party of the second part, hereinafter called the Lessee, WITNESSETH:

The Lessor has leased to the Lessor and the Lessoe has leased of the Lessor that portion of a building owned by the Lessor on the corner of Cedar Lene Road and Woodside Avenue, near the City of Greenville, S. C., nov occupied by the Lessee, being the greery store located on the first floor.

The price agreed upon to be paid by the Lessee and accepted by the Lessor is Thirty (\$30.00) Dellars per month for a period of one year, commencing September 1, 1933, the first payment to be due on October 1, 1933, and being the rent for the month of September 1953, and monthly thereafter on the first of each and every month. The Lessor grants to the lesses an option of an additional two years lease on the same terms as above stated, but should it desire to exercise this option, it is to advise the Lessor in writing ninety (90) days before the expiration of the one year period.

It is understood and agreed that the lessee is to pay all water bills and light bills for all water and electric current used by the occupants of the property herein leased.

It is understood and agreed that the Lessee is to maintain the building in as good condition as it now is and is to pay for all necessary repairs, ordinary wear and to ar excepted, and that the lesser is not to be responsible for any damage caused by leakage

This lease is not to be assigned without the consent of the lessor. It is further agreed that should the Lossee fail to pay the rent when due that upon being ten days in arrears, the Lacor at his option may cause this lease canculled and terminated, or he may consider that the full amount of the lease is then due and payable, not ifying the lessee of which option he selects. The lessee agrees to passeably surrender possession of the premises upon any default by it of the terms of this lease.
