Beginning at the Northwest corner of lot of land conveyed by the grantor to J. S. Truman, 330 acre by deed recorded in Deed Book 74, page 20, R. M. C., Office for Greenville County, and running thence N. 70° 45' W. 61 feet, more or less, to southwest corner of lot formerly conveyed by grantor to C. G. Milford by deed recorded in Deed Book 79, page 238, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County; thence along line of property of the grantee and Nellie A. Massey S. 19° 15' E. 79 feet, more or less, to the northwestern corner of lot formerly conveyed by the grantor to J. S. Massey by deed recorded in Deed Book 83, page 425, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County; thence S. 70° 45' E. 61 feet, more or less, to northeastern corner of lot conveyed by grantor to J. L. Putman by deed recorded in Deed Book 91, page 43, R. M. C.
