Charles and having the following course and distances according to plat of said subdivision, recorded in Plat Sub-Divt Book E, page 209: Beginning at an iron pin on the west side of Texas Avenue 840 feet north of Eastley Bridge Road, corner of lot no 11, and running thence with line of said lot S. 71 W. 200 feet to iron pins, corner of lot no 12; thence with line of said lot N. 22-10 W. 80 feet to iron pin, corner of lot no 15; thence with line of said lot N. 71 E. 200 feet to iron pin on Texas Avenue, and running thence with Texas Avenue S. 22-10 E. 80 feet to the beginning.
