in the City of Greenville, on the south side of Sullivan Street, having the following metes and bounds:

Beginning at John Brockman's corner on Sullivan Street, thence running with Sullivan Street S 89-15 E 50.5 feet, thence with Goldenwith's line S 2-50 W 129.1 feet, thence N 86 W 50 feet with Sullivan Street School lot to a pin, thence N 3-30 W 125.5 feet with joint Brockman line to the beginning corner, and being the same lot conveyed to me the said Haskell Brockman by Mrs. A. C. Davis deed dated March 16, 1926, recorded in Deed Book 106 page 460, R. M. C. Office for said Greenville County.
