all that given, part or lot of land in Brenton Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

near the town of Simpsonville originally adjoining lots number one and three in the divisions of the land of Amanda J. Stokes (deceased), and having the following metes and bounds, beginning at an iron pin in the road and thence S 28 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 2753 to stone, thence N 63 $\frac{1}{4}$  W 3.00 to stone, thence N 48 W 4.00 to stone (Electricty house) thence N 85 $\frac{1}{4}$  W 3.11 to Sweet Gum stone N 28 $\frac{1}{2}$  E 26.38 to stone, thence S. 55 $\frac{1}{4}$  E 8.05 to the beginning containing twenty-one and one-half acres more or less.
