It is Ordered, That the said Trustee's Report of Exempted Property be, and the same is hereby in all respects confirmed and the Bankrupt's claim to exemptions as set out in said Report is hereby determined accordingly. Exemption on the real estate described in the Trustee's Report is allowed subject to mortgage on said property in the sum of Two Thousand Eight Hundred Eighty-five and 57/100 (\$2,885.57) Dollars, held by the Federal Land Bank of Columbia, S. C., recorded in Mortgage Book 86, Page 3.

The following is a description of the real estate set aside to the Bankrupt as exemption by this Order.

"All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greentlle County, State of South Carolina, on the East side of the Buncembe Road and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin on bank of said Buncombe Road and running thence N. 34½ E. 23.25 chains to stone, old Cleveland corner; thence S. 85½ E. 9.65 chains to an iron pin at sourwood tree; thence S. 33 3/4 W.
