Whereas by an instrument dated the first day of Wareh, 1928, Central Baptist Church, a corporation created and existing under the laws of the State of South Carelina, did execute a dead of trust and mortgage in favor of Whitney Central Trust and Savings Bank, Trustee, securing the payment of its First Mortgage Six (6%) per cent. Serial Gold Bonds issued thereunder, which said deed of trust and mortgage is of record in the office of the Clerk of Court of Greenville County, South Carolina, and to the same and the record thereof reference is nereby made for further particulars; and
