E. Hellams, adjoining land of Russell Batee, Mose Martin, Sam. Jones and others.

Beginning on a rock in the foot of branch, thence running N $\frac{1}{4}$ E. 16.00 che. to a R. O. stump 0 m., thence N. 23 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 24.75 to the center of the White Horse Road, thence down said road. 7.13 to iron Pin, Mose Martin's corner, thence due South 3.00 to a bend, thence S. 21 $\frac{1}{4}$ E. 6.50 to a bend; thence S 64 W. 3.00 to a bend, thence S 76 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 6.75 to a stake in road, thence S. 44 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 2.56 to a stone, thence 1.22 to a poplar stump at the head of a branch, thence down the meanderings of branch 20.40 to the beginning corner and contains 29 acres, more or less.
