by Mrs. Della R. Ellis the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Mrs. Della R. Ellis, her heirs and assigns forever:

All those certain pieces, parcels or lots of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Greenville Township, near the City of Greenville, and being known and designated as Lots No. 22 and 23 of Augusta Place, as shown by Plat made by R. E. Dalton, May 19th 1933, and recorded in the G. M. C. Office for Greenville County, in Plat Book F, page 128, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at a stake on Augusta Place Street and running thence N. 63.30 E. 374.7 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 29.27 E. 187.8 feet to an iron pipe; thence S. 58.35 W. 443 feet to a stake on Augusta Place Street; thence in a curved line 155.8 feet to a stake on line of Lots 22 and 23; thence continuing N. 1.30 W. 110 feet to the point of beginning, as will appear from the plat above referred to.
