in consideration of the sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) and the assumption of a certain mortgage recited below DOLLARS,

to us paid by Ida J. Dacus

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said Ida J. Dacus her heirs and assigns - all our right,

title and interest in the undivided one-half interest, which the said H. J. Dacus owned in the following described property.

One lot of land situate and lying in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, having the following meter and bounds: Beginning at an iron pin on the southwest corner of the intersection of the P. & N. Railroad right-of-way with Runcombe Road, and running thence N. 81° 05' W. 250.5 feet to an iron pin located near or on the corner of Runcombe Road and Pike Road - thence along Pike Road S. 7° 00' E. 465 feet to an iron pin on said road - thence along Pike Road S. 15° 10' W. 80.4 feet to an iron pin on the right-of-way of the P. & N. Railroad, thence with the right-of-way of the P. & N. Railroad N. 23° 10' E. 544 feet to an iron pin, the beginning corner; the lot containing 1. <sup>4</sup>/<sub>100</sub> acres, more or less and is that lot shown on plat of Dalton & Neves, dated September 14, 1928.

The F. W. Poe Manufacturing Company agrees to allow a sewer line to be run along the Runcombe Road to the sewer trunk line now in place.
