All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville County, Greenville Township, State of South Carolina, on what is known as the White Horse Road (now known as Washington Avenue), and known as Lots nos 1 and 2 of a court division of what is known as the old slopes - Haven property according to plat of said property recorded in the R.
