At Greenville, S. C., in said District, on the 30th day of January, A. D. 1934, before the Honorable H. H. Watkins, Judge of said Court in Bankruptcy, the petition of James Robert Martin, Greenville, S. C., Greenville County and meaning of the Acts of Congress relating to bankruptcy, having been heard and duly considered, the said James Robert Martin is hereby declared and adjudged a bankrupt accordingly.

It is therefore ordered that upon the petition filed in this Court by said bankrupt on the 30th day of January, A. D. 1934, said matter be referred to Hon. E. M. Blythe, Greenville, S. C., one of the Referees in Bankruptcy of this Court, to take such further proceedings thereon as are required by said Acts, and that the said James Robert Martin shall attend before said Referee on the 13th day of February, 1934, at 11 o'clock in the forenoon and thenceforth shall submit to such orders as may be made by said Referee or by this Court relating to said voluntary bankruptcy.

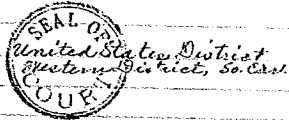
