Lucy D. King her heirs and assigns all that lot of land situate on the south side of West Washington Street, in the City and County of Greenville, South Carolina, and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a stake on West Washington Street at the corner of the Mette lot and running thence along said street S. 66 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 60 feet and 2 inches to a corner on the N.W. lot, thence with the line of that lot S. 23 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 217.5 feet to a stake on the land formerly owned by the Estate of John Westfield; thence N. 66 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 60 feet and 2 inches to corner of the Mette lot; thence with the line of that lot N. 23 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 217.5 feet to the beginning corner.
