This Deed made this 1st. day of November, 1935, between George B. Compton, of New York, New York, as Trustee of Interstate Mortgage Company, Debtor, party of the first part, and National Bondholders Corporation, duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Delaware, and having an office and place of business at 90 West Street, City, County and State of New York, party of the second part.

Witnesseth:

That, for and in consideration of the sum of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars and of other valuable considerations paid by the party of the second part to the party of the first part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part doth hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part, its successors and assigns, the following described property located in Greenville County, South Carolina:

All that tract or parcel of land situated lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, in Ward Six (6) of the City of Greenville, having the following meters and bounds to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin 65 feet from the intersection of Victory Avenue and Fairview Avenue (formerly Gibson Street), and running thence along Fairview Avenue N. 3-33.6. 65 feet to an iron pipe; thence S. 85-0 E. 150 feet to an iron pipe; thence S. 3-33 W. 65 feet to an iron pipe; thence N. 85-0 W. 150 feet to the beginning corner. The east side of Fairview Avenue. To Have And To Hold, the good premises, with all the rights, easements and appurtenances thereto belonging to the said party of the second part, its successors and assigns forever.
