

General Permit

1.00 received of the Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company One and 00/100 dollars in consideration of which I hereby grant unto said company, its associated and allied companies, their respective successors and assigns, the right, privilege, and authority to construct, operate and maintain its lines of Telephone and Telegraph, and for the general transmission of intelligence, consisting of such poles, wires, cables, conduits, guys, anchors and other fixtures and appurtenances as the grantee may from time to time require, upon, across, over and/or under the property which I own for in which I have any interest in the County of Greenville as do platte streets, or highways, adjoining the said property, and the right to permit the attachment of and/or carry in conduit wires or cables of any other company or person, and with the further right to trim and cut down and to keep trimmed and cut down all trees and undergrowth within 10 feet of said line, and in addition thereto, the grantee shall have the right to put down, from time to time, all dead, weak, leaning or dangerous trees that are tall enough to reach the wires on said line, said sums being received in full payment for the rights herein granted.

The above mentioned line to be constructed just off edge of the Casley Bridge road.
