know All was by these Presents: That the undersigned, of baid County and State, hareinsfter called Grantor, for and in consideration of the terms, conditions and privileges hereinafter expressed, and the sum of one (\$1.00) Dollar to the Grantor in hand paid by

Augusta Road, Water and Sever Sub-District, of Greenville Couth Carolina, the receipt (whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant unto the said Grantse, its successors and assigns, the right, privilege and easement to go in and upon that tract at let of land situate in Greenville Township, in said County and State, and described as follows: on Southwest side of Augusta Road about three miles from Greenville Courthouse, said easement extends about 1600 feet over property of grantor, including about 300 feet in existing readway.

and to construct, maintain in and upon and use in and through said promises, in a proper manner, with necessary apparatus and applicates such as machinery, air vents, manholes, blowerf acmostions and any and every other necessary and proper attachment, pipe lines, for water and severage purposes through the premises above described, together with the right at all times to enter in and upon said promises for the purpose of inspecting and making necessary repairs and alterations of said line, together with the right to cut away and keep clear of said pipe lines all trees and other obstructions that may be any way endanger the proper operations of same.

It Is Understood and Agreed: That the easement herein granted shall extend throughout the property of the Granter about 1600 feat and shall be of such width as the Grantes shall deem necessary for the purposes herein specified, and that the damage for which said Grantes may be held liable shall be confined to that existing from the use of this strip only, and nothing beyond.

It is further agreed and Understood: That this easement is to be used only during the construction or repair of said pipe lines and with the exception of the right of the Grantee, its successors and assigns, agents, servants, and employees to inspect said tipe lines and to enter at any point and make repairs, the Granter has the right to cultivate and use the land; provided, however, that this shall not apply to such part wherein the top of the ripe is less than eighteen (18) inches underground.

It is Further agreed: That, as a part of the consideration hereof, the Grantor herein and the heirs and assigns of the same, was make tags or connections with said pipe lines bearing the expense thereof, provided, however, that such connections or taps be made only under the rules and supervision of the engineers representing the Grantee, its successors and assigns.

It is Further Understood and agreed: That in case of future damage to crops or property due from accident in said pusp pipe lines, the Grantee small pay reasonable damage therefor.

The payment and privileges above specified are hereby associated in full settlement of all claims and damages for said samement.
