

For And In consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) to me in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledge, and for other good and valuable consideration, I, N. A. Merritt, of Greenville, S. C. hereby sell, assign, transfer and set over unto The Estate of J. H. Miller, Deceased, whose address is Rock Hill, S. C., all my right, title and interest in and to any and all renewal commissions that have already accrued or which may in the future accrue to me, under or in connection with my contract with The Equitable Life Assurance Society of the United States dated March 1st, 1933.

And Further, I do for myself, my heirs, executors, administrators or assigns, hereby guarantee the validity and sufficiency of the foregoing assignment to the said Estate of J. H. Miller, and its right, title and interest under said assignment and in and to said renewal commissions will forever warrant and defend, and further declare that I have made no other assignment of commissions so assigned and am now the sole owner thereof.

It Is Understood And Agreed, that the foregoing assignment is given as collateral security for the repayment by me of any and all moneys heretofore loaned or may hereafter be loaned to me by the said Estate of J. H. Miller, with interest thereon at the rate of six per cent per annum, and upon the repayment of said amount, said Estate of J. H. Miller will reassign to me in writing the commission interest hereby conveyed.

It Is further Understood And Agreed that the foregoing assignment is made subject to the terms and conditions of the aforesaid contract dated March 1st, 1933 and subject also to any claim of the said Society present or future, including any and all indebtedness from whatever cause and whenever arising.
