COURT OF COMMON PLEAS

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME

I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, The Federal Land Bank of Columbia,

on or about the 2nd day of May in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and thirty five exhibited its complaint in the Court of Common Pleas for the County aforesaid, against W. T. Allison, et al.

demanding judgment in relation to the real estate hereinafter mentioned and described; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 17th day of October 1935, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a Decree

of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described be sold by E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, on the terms and for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court will appear; and the Master, after having duly advertised the said real estate

for sale by public outcry on the 4th day of November in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and thirty five, did then openly and publicly, according to the custom of auctions, sell and dispose of the same unto The Federal Land Bank of Columbia,

for the sum of Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars, being at that price the highest bidder therefor.

NOW, THEREFORE, Know All Men by These Presents, That I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Five hundred (\$500.00) Dollars to me paid by the said The Federal Land Bank of Columbia,

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Federal Land Bank of Columbia,

"All that certain tract of land situate, in Dunklin Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, containing 81 acres; bounded by the lands of R. B. Allison, Robt. Chapman, McKittrick and tract No. 1 of the R. B. Allison estate. For a more accurate description reference is hereby craved to plat of same made by W. F. Lee, Surveyor, Feb. 12, 1917, attached to and made a part of the abstract, less 4 acres conveyed to Lickville School District May 22, 1924, by deed recorded in Vol. 99, Page 72.

All that certain tract or parcel of land situate in Dunklin Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing 40.12 acres, more or less; bounded on the North by lands of McKittrick; on the East by lands of Davenport; on the South by lands of J. J. Dean and on the West by lands of W. T. Allison. For a more accurate description of said tract reference is hereby craved to plat of same attached to and made a part of the abstract."
