the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said Federal Farm Mortgage Corporation

"All that tract or parcel of land containing 38.70 acres, in Dunklin Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, known as the E. A. Kirby place, located on the Pinson Public Road, 4 miles from Princeton, on the waters of Horse Creek, bounded on the North by lands of Mrs. Emma Thompson; on the East by lands of J. L. Shumate; on the South by lands of J. B. Thompson, on the West by lands of E. A. Kirby, and having the following courses and distances according to Survey and plat of J. W. Riddle, Surveyor, May, 1934.
