I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, George Norwood, as Conservator of the Peoples Building and Loan Association, a Corporation.

on or about the 17th day of November in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and thirty-six exhibited his complaint in the Court of Common Pleas for the County aforesaid, against Mrs. M. A. Lister, and the heirs at law and distributees of Mrs. M. A. Lister, whose names, addresses and whereabouts are unknown,

demanding judgment in relation to the real estate hereinafter mentioned and described; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 15th day of January, 1937, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a Decree

NOW, THEREFORE, Know All Men by These Presents, That E. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One hundred (\$100.00) Dollars to me paid by the said James H. Perry and Lillie Mae Perry.

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said James M. Perry and Lillie Mae Perry.

"All that certain place, parcel or lot of land in Greenville county, State of South Carolina, known and designated as Lot no. 6 on sub-division of Lot No. 32, plat of Marie Sub-division, property of Looper and town, said plat having been recorded in the office of the R. & C. for Greenville County in plat Book "F", page 77, and having the following metes and bounds:

Beginning at a stake on the north side of Wilbanks Street, 164.2 feet from White Horse Road; running thence N. 15.00 W. 200 feet to a stake in line of Lot no. 33, thence with line of said lot, S. 79.45 W. 50 feet to an iron pin, corner Lot no. 34; thence with line of said lot S. 15.00 E. 200 feet to an iron pin on Wilbanks Street; thence with said Wilbanks Street N. 79-45 E. 50 feet to the point of beginning."
