All that certain lot or parcel of land situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being a part of the East Lybrel Addition and being known and designated on a plat made by Dalton + Menes, engineers as Lot No. 122 said plat being recorded in Plat Book "H," page 220 in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County on May 20, 1933.

Beginning at a point on the north side of Sycamore Drive one hundred feet from S.W. corner of Sycamore Drive and Johnston Street and running thence N. 28-55 E. 150 feet to an iron pin in line of lot 122, thence N. 61-10 W. 50 feet to an iron pin corner of Lot 121, thence S. 28-55 W. 150 feet to an iron pin on Sycamore Drive, thence with Sycamore Drive S. 61-10 E. 50 feet to the beginning corner.
