to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee..... hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged)  
has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto H. B. Jones,

and his heirs and assigns, forever;  
all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate  
lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South  
Carolina, near the corporate limits of the City of Greenville  
being known and designated as Lot no. 6 on a revised plat  
of property of B. E. Bell made in February, 1929, by R. M. Past,  
Engineer, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville  
County in Plat Book "B" at Page 143, and having, according  
to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on Blue Ridge Drive (formerly Arlington Avenue), joint corner of Lots nos. 5 and 6, and  
running thence with said Blue Ridge Drive N. 83-55 E. 66  
feet to an iron pin, thence S. 5-45 E. 200 feet to an iron pin,  
thence S. 83-55 W. 66 feet to an iron pin, thence N. 5-45 W. 200  
feet to an iron pin, the beginning corner; this being the same  
property conveyed to Southern Investment Corporation by George  
W. Gandy, Jr., by deed dated June 11, 1936, and recorded in the
