Cascade Power Company.

All that cert. in piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, beginning at a point on the West side of Brandon Road (sometimes called Smyth Street or Woodside Ave.), and running thence N. 13-50 E. 57-0 to a point on the south line of property now or formerly owned by Mrs. Garren and known as lot 79; thence second N. 88-21 W. 111.6 to a point at the corner of the fence in said line and at the end of the second course described in deed from said W. R. Hale to Mary, Gaillard, dated January 13, 1913, recorded in Book 24 page 76; thence third along the said mentioned line S. 2 ft. 27 in. 71.55-8 feet to a point on the north side of Summit St.; thence fourth along said north side of Summit St. S. 88 ft. 25 in. E. 100.4 feet to the point of place of beginning, and being a portion of lot 78 of the subdivision called Morgan Hill Addition which is shown more fully on a plat recorded in the office of R. M.
