in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain sell and release, unto the said J. M. Gault under terms of will of James M. Gault.

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Fairview Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing eight (8) acres and more particularly described by a plat made by W. J. Riddle November 10, 1888 as follows:
Beginning at an iron pin joint corner of lands of Joe Leake, Pearce Bpling and J. M. Gault Estate running thence North 77-15 E. 729 feet to an iron pin; thence North 28-30 East 458 feet along line of R. Bryson estate; to a flint; thence S. 62-21 W. 997 feet to an iron pin; thence S. approximately 500 feet along line of property cut off to J. Babe Gault to the beginning corner.
