in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, we granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain sell and release, unto the said Bessie P. Renfroe

a certain tract or parcel of land situated in the state aforesaid and county of Greenville, known as lot no. 4 of the division of George W. Plumley, state as shown on plat made by St. H. Ladshaw, December 16, 1936 and March 1937, containing 19 acres more or less.

Also lot no. 1, in the division of lots within the town of Landrum, Spartanburg County and the state aforesaid, containing $\frac{1}{3} \frac{1}{10}$ acres more or less. Deeds to be recorded in Spartanburg and Greenville.

The above described lot no. 4 is a part of the land the same conveyed to Geo W. Plumley by Rev. A. S. Bonner April 5th 1900, recorded on the 1st day of October 1900, in Book D, Page 172, Greenville County.

Lot no. 1, in the town of Landrum, being part of the land the same conveyed to Geo W. Plumley by W. H. Finger, the same being part of land conveyed to W. H. Finger by St. E. Smith by deed recorded in Deed Book 6-13 Page 301, Spartanburg County.
