Coleman, adjoining lots of Broder Bates and J. E. Coleman Sr. Estate. Beginning on an iron pin Grove Bates corner running thence N. 7 1/4 W. 40 feet to an i. p. thence S. 82 3/4 W. 11 feet to an iron pin, thence S. 7 1/4 E. 40 feet to an i. p. thence N. 82 1/4 E. 11 feet to the beginning corner and contains 440 sq. feet.
