KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I. D. F. Reynolds

in the State aforesaid,
in consideration of the sum of One Hundred DOLLARS

to me paid by Dora L. Baston

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain sell and release,
unto the said Dora L. Baston.

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land
situate, lying and being in the County and
Township of Greenville, State of South Carolina,
about one half mile west of the corporate limits
of the City of Greenville known as a part of Lot
No. 4 of Marshall's addition to the City of
Greenville according to a plat of said addition
made by J. N. Southern on December 1897,
and filed in Deed Book "E 6 E" page 658, and
having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
Beginning at a stake on the north side of an
alley 130 feet from Cedar Lane Road on the south
side of Lot No. 5 of Marshall's addition, and
running thence along said alley S. 40° E. 50 feet
more or less to a stake on alley, thence N.
31° E. 150 feet to Lot No. 24; thence along line
of Lot No. 24 N. 40° E. 50 feet to a stake;
thence S. 31° E. 150 feet along line of Lot No. 5
to the beginning corner.
