All that piece, parcel, lot or tract of land lying, being and situate in Greenville County State aforesaid, and Greenville Township, having the following miles and bounds: beginning at a stone on the S. J. Seyle corner and running W. 13 1/2 W. 550 to a stone; thence S. 58 1/2 W. 1.95 to a stone; thence S. 13 1/2 E. 550 to a stone; thence W. 58 1/2 E. 1.95 to the beginning corner. Containing one acre more or less, a dividing lands of S. J. Seyle, Ben Birne, J. K. Earle, & Burdine and a plot of the above lands was made J. W. Southern, D. S. on the 21st day of April 1893 which is the same property conveyed by S. J. Seyle to the trustees of Mountain View, A. M. C. Church on the 21st day of April 1893 which was conveyed to me by said S. J. Seyle on or during the year 1907 or 1908 as trustee of Mountain View Baptist Church and being in my possession individually and held as such ever since the same lying and being on both sides of the Bramlett Road and includes the colored cemetery on the north side of said road.
