HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said Mrs. Lou Bright

"All that tract of land in Saluda Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on
Terry Creek, and bounded by the lands of D. W. Patterson on the south; C. M. Morgan on the
southwest; Thurstons on the west; Jas. A. Bright on the northwest; N.K. Neilson on the north
and W. B. Barton on the east, and containing 86 acres, more or less; this being the same tract
of land to which their interest in, the said Lou Bright owning the remaining interest, on June
18, 1935, deed recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, on June 18,
1936, in Deed Book 178, page 250."
