All our right, title and interest to and in all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land, situate, lying and being in Butler Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, on West side of Enoree River, near Gibbs Shoal, about two miles from Pelham, S. C. Known as the estate lands of the Late J. P. Green deceased, and having the following lines and distances to-wit:

Beginning at a stake on west side of Enoree River opposite stone in midst of River at Greene Shoal, known as the corner of Tract No. 2, as shown on Plat of the Estate lands of the late J. P. Greene made by M.O. Owens, Nov. 6-7, 1934, go S. 46 W. 6.00 to pine, new marks; thence S. 1 W. 17.45 to stake; thence S. 50 W. 4.70 to stone at corner of lands of Mrs. Mamie Smith and Miss Minnie Greene; thence N. 45 W. 3.22 to stake; thence N. 73 W. 9.05 to stake in bend of gully; thence S. 71½ W. 2.60 to stake on rock dam in gully; thence S. 16 W. 5.32 to stake in Old Road; thence N. 36 W. with old road 4.43 to stake near Lucust Tree; thence S. 53 W. 1.80 to stake in old Road; thence N. 51 W. 5.88 to stake in Old Road; thence S. 82½ W. with Old Rod 1.65 to stake in old Road; thence N. 48 ¾ E. 12.00 to stake; thence N. 14 E. 11.28 to stake at mouth of Tanyard branch as it enters Enoree River; thence down the west bank of Enoree River to the beginning corner, containing fifty two (52) acres. All of which is more fully shown on a plat of the Estate lands of the Late J. P. Greene made by M. O. Owens November 6-7, 1934, and designated on said plat as tract No. 8.
