HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said

W. A. Floyd and W. S. Griffin, Jr.

"All that certain lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of
South Carolina, on Paris Mountain Road, being all of Lot No. 19 and a portion of Lots Nos.
17, 18, 24, 25, 26 and 27 of the Subdivision known as Oakwood; Beginning at a stake on
Paris Mountain Road at corner of lot sold to T. P. Hartness, and running thence with Paris
Mountain Road N. 1-0 E. approximately 300 feet to iron pin on Goldsmith Street; thence with
Goldsmith Street approximately 360 feet to stake at intersection of Goldsmith Street and
Henry Street; thence with Henry Street S. 41-30 E. approximately 160 feet to stake at corner
of Lot sold to T. P. Hartness; thence with Hartness line S. 89-0 E. 120 feet to beginning
corner."
