All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the south side of Woodvale Avenue near the City of Greenville in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 248 on plat of Traxler Park made by R. E. Dalton, March, 1923, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book F, at pages 114 and 115, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:-

Beginning at an iron pin on the south side of Woodvale Avenue, joint corner of Lots No. 248 and 249, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 249, S. 25-23 E. 202.5 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 62-34 W. 70.05 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot No. 247, N. 25-23 W. 205 feet to an iron pin on the south side of Woodvale Avenue; thence with the south side of Woodvale Avenue N. 64-37 E. 70 feet to the beginning corner.
