State and County aforesaid and near the Town of Fountain Inn, containing three (3) acres, more
or less, being all of the two lots of land conveyed to the said George McDaniel and Leila Gold-
smith by deed of L. G. Hughes and J. B. Hughes recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville
County in Deed Book 200, at page 246, Bounded by lands of James Richardson Estate, A. S. Peden
Estate, et al.
