All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

lying and being on the East side of Mary Street and known and designated as Lot No. 70 on Map 1 of Camilla Park, recorded in Plat Book "G" at page 225 and having the following notes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on Mary Street, corner of Lots 70 and 71, and running thence with joint line of said lots, N. 68-02 E. 202.7 feet to an iron pin on a 20 foot alley; thence with said alley, S. 18-32 E. 67.95 feet to an iron pin corner of Lot 69; thence with joint line of Lots 69 and 70, S. 68-00 W. 200 feet to an iron pin on Mary Street; thence with said Mary Street, N. 20-45 W. 68 feet to the beginning corner.

This conveyance is made subject to the following restrictions:

1. That the said land shall be used exclusively for residential purposes for white persons only and that the said land shall never be sold, rented or otherwise disposed of to any person wholly or partly of African descent.
2. That no building shall be erected on said lots costing less than the sum of \$1,000.00.
3. That no building shall be erected nearer the front line of said lot than 30 feet nor nearer than ten feet from either side line or nearer than five feet from the rear line of said lot.
4. That the grantor reserves to itself and its successors the right to authorize them placing, maintaining and repairing of any and all public utilities in the streets without compensation to any lot owner.
5. That no surface closet nor cess pool shall ever be maintained on said land, but only septic tanks or other sanitary sewerage.
6. That no use shall be made of said lot which would constitute a nuisance to the adjoining lot owner.
