TITLE TO REAL ESTATE

Garraux County Treasurer of said Greenville County, did issue his warrants directed to the Delinquent Tax Collector for said County and State by authority of the acts of the General Assembly of South Carolina and the statute laws of said State, against E. Ashmore, Delinquent Tax Collector of and for the County and State aforesaid, in consideration of the premises, and the sum of Seventy & 00/100 Dollars to me paid by the said grantee(x), Dacus Odom have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, sell, bargain and release unto the said grantee(x), Dacus Odom his heirs and assigns:

All that lot, tract or parcel of land located in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville and in Greenville Township and known as lot #6 of block "V" of a plat of the subdivision of "Riverside", For a more complete description see deed of Carrie Middlebrooks to E. V. Lanford as recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 90, page 150.

Together with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

To Have and to hold all and singular the premises hereby granted, with the appurtenances, unto the said Dacus Odom, his heirs and assigns, forever, according to the form in force and effect of the laws and usages of the State; of South Carolina in such cases made and provided.
