(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said
Caroline B. Moseley, her Heirs and assigns, forever:-

All those certain pieces, parcels or lots of land in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, near the City of Greenville, and being known and designated as Lots No. 6, 7 and 43, according to a plat of Sans Souci Highlands, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book G, at page 126, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:-

Lots No. 6 and 7.

Beginning at an iron pin on the South side of Ellendale Avenue, joint front corner of Lots No. 7 and 8 of Sans Souci Highlands, which said pin is 104 feet Southeast of the Southeast corner of the intersection of Ellendale Avenue and Furman Road, and running thence with line of Lot No. 8, S. 32-33 W. 149 feet to an iron pin in the line of Lot No. 10; thence S. 48-23 E. 100 feet to an iron pin joint rear corner of Lots No. 5 and 6; thence with the line of Lot No. 5, N. 32-33 E. 149 feet to an iron pin on the South side of Ellendale Avenue; thence with the South side of Ellendale Avenue, N. 48-23 W. 50 feet to the beginning corner.

Lot No. 43.

Beginning at an iron pin on the West side of Sunshine Avenue, which iron pin is 155 feet Southwest of the Southwest corner of the intersection of Sunshine Avenue and Ellendale Avenue, and running thence with the rear lines of Lots No. 4, 5 and 6, N. 48-23 W. 160 feet to an iron pin in the rear line of Lot No. 6, and on the Southeast side of an alley; thence with the Southeast side of said alley, S. 28-30 W. 100.9 feet to an iron pin corner of Lot No. 42; thence with the line of Lot No. 42, S. 67-00 E. 161 feet to an iron pin on the West side of Sunshine Avenue; thence with the West side of Sunshine Avenue, N. 22-30 E. 50 feet to the beginning corner.
