All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Highland.....Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

about one and one half miles East from Pleasant Hill Baptist Church, on the South side of the Pink Dill Mill Road, and being a part of the same land conveyed to me by deed from J. N. Page January 6th 1919 and recorded in the office of the R. M. C. in and for Greenville County in Deed Book 44 at page 342, and being bounded on the North by the said Pink Dill Mill Road and other lands of myself and lands of Weldon Black, on the East by lands of John Peace, on the South by Barn's Branch and lands of Mrs. Corrice King and Mrs. Boyd Ross, and on the West by lands of Tom Forrester, and having the following courses and distances, to wit:-

BEGINNING on a point in the center of the Pink Dill Mill Road, the same being the joint corner of Weldon Black, John Peace, Edgar Fitz and the tract being conveyed, and runs thence with the John Peace line S. 55-45 E. 280 feet to an iron pin, Peace's corner; thence continueing with the Peace line S. 13-40 E. 807 feet to an iron pin in the Barn's Branch, John Peace's corner; thence up and with the meanders of the said branch as follows: N. 74-25 W. 147 feet to bend; S. 45-38 W. 163.6 feet to bend; N. 88-40 W. 100 feet to bend; S. 64-34 W. 269 feet to bend; N. 80-49 W. 304.5 feet to bend; S. 42-22 W. 193 feet to bend; S. 33-40 W. 98 feet to bend; S. 20-00 W. 194.5 feet to bend; S. 9-10 E. 121 feet to bend; S. 65-10 W. 171 feet to a point in the Barns branch (iron pin on the North bank of the branch) and being on the Tom Forrester line; thence with the Tom Forrester line N. 48-30 W. 102 feet to an iron pin at the old run of the creek and near a large Poplar Stump, Tom Forrester corner; thence continueing with the Forrester line N. 53-00 W. 1764.5 to a point in the center of the Pink Dill Mill Road (iron pin on the South bank of the road); thence with the center of the said road N. 66-05 E. 1200 feet to a point in the said road near the intersection of another road; thence continueing with the center of the Pink Dill Mill Road N. 63-20 E. 200 feet to bend; N. 65-33 E. 200 feet to bend; N. 74-53 E. 100 feet to bend; N. 85-31 E. 100 feet to bend; S. 78-54 E. 100 feet to bend; S. 66-44 E. 300 feet to bend; S. 70-24 E. 100 feet to bend; N. 87-13 E. 100 feet to bend; N. 73-00 E. 144.5 feet to the beginning corner and containing Sixty Two and Thirty One-hundredths (62.30) Acres, more or less.
